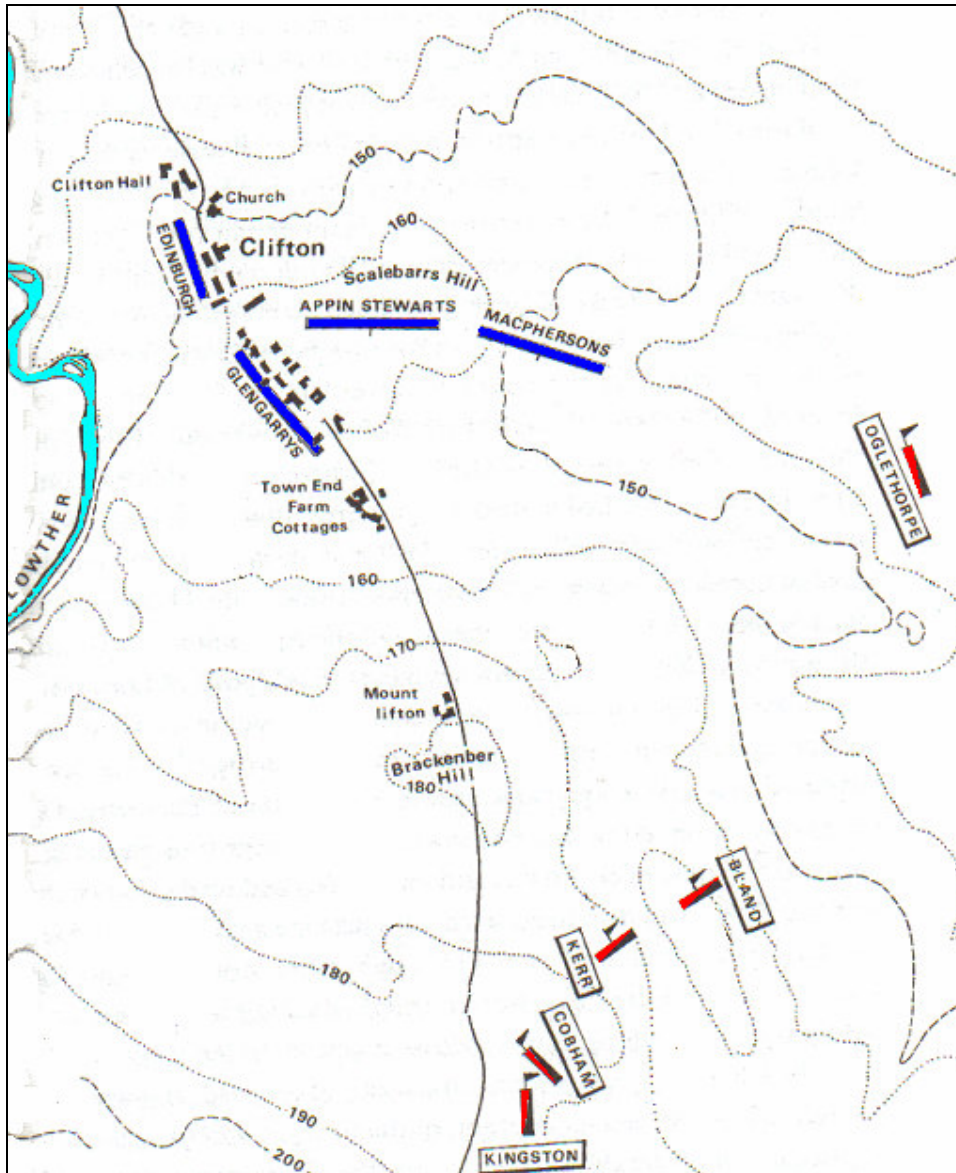


Clifton Moor – December 18, 1745.

On 18 December 1745, an army under William, Duke of Cumberland stumbled into an army of his cousin, the Jacobite Prince Charles Stewart, on a moor outside Penrith. This was to be the last battle ever fought on English soil ..

To make the re-fight of the battle a little more interesting each side has a number of options laid out in it's briefing, these relate to a number of plausible what-ifs that have been well documented over the years.
